My Love Heart

hair clip • brooch

This simple and sweet My Love Heart Pattern has endless possibilities! Once you start, you won't stop!

Try some of these to get started:

- Hair Clips
- Ponytail Holders
- Headbands
- Pins for your hat, purse, book bag or coat
- Decorate cards or use them in a scrapbook
- Enlarge this pattern to decorate pillows for your home

Heart Hair Clip

My Love Heart Hair Clip

Finished Dimensions: 1.5" x 2"

Material List

- 6" x 6" red wool felt
- 4" x 4" pink wool felt
- Embroidery floss – red, pink
- Hair Clip – 1 ½" metal snap clip



Step 1

Using the patterns, cut a set of two large hearts from the red felt and one small heart from the pink felt.

Step 2

Stack your petal pieces and trim the edges together. This gets all the fuzzy pieces off and helps keep the hearts even.

Step 3

Take one large red heart and stack the small pink heart on the top.

Step 4

Using red embroidery floss {6 strands} start from the wrong {back, bottom...whatever you want to call it} side and start sewing the pink heart to the red heart as seen in the photo.

You will use a simple running stitch all the way around. Once you finish your last stitch at the top just tie a knot on the wrong side.

Set this aside for now.



Step 5

Take the back of your bottom heart and place the hair clip in the center facing to the right.

Step 6

Starting from the wrong side with red or pink floss secure the hair clip in place with stitches all the way around. When you are finished, tie a knot on the wrong side.

Step 7

Stack your top and bottom heart together and start sewing them together. Use the pink floss {6 strands} and a running stitch beginning from the back of the hair clip. Sew all the way around the pink heart and finish with a knot on the back.



Step 8

Carefully trim around the edge to even out the layers and give it a finished look.

You're done! I'm sure this won't be your last felt heart!

Heart Variations:

- Use matching thread or contrasting colors
- Stitch an initial in the center
- Add beads or small buttons in the smaller heart

This sweet pin makes a great gift!

Share Your Heart Pin

Finished Dimensions: 2" x 2"

Material List

- 6" x 6" red wool felt
- 4" x 4" pink wool felt
- Embroidery floss – red, pink
- Pin – ¾" metal pin

Step 1

Using the patterns, cut a set of two circles from the red felt and one small heart from the pink felt.

Step 2

Stack your circle pieces and trim the edges together. This gets all the fuzzy pieces off and helps keep the circles even.

Step 3

Take one red circle and stack the small pink heart on the top, centered.

Step 4

Using red embroidery floss {separate out and use just 2 strands for this stitch} start from the wrong side and start sewing the pink heart to the red circle with a **backstitch**.

Sew all the way around and back to the top. Finish with a knot on the wrong side.

Set this aside for now.

Step 5

Take the back of your bottom circle and place the pin in the center facing to the right. Sew around it until it is secure.

Step 6

Stack your top and bottom circle together and start sewing them together near the edge of the circle. Use the red floss {2 strands} and a backstitch beginning from the back of the pin. Sew all the way around and finish with a knot on the back.



Step 7

Carefully trim around the edge to even out the layers and give it a finished look.

Make one for yourself and one to share!

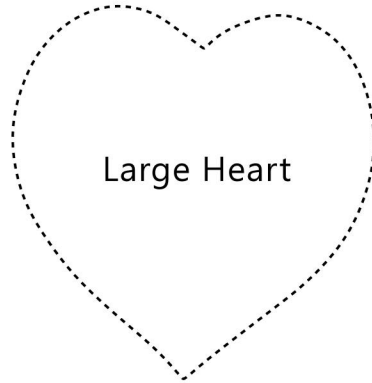

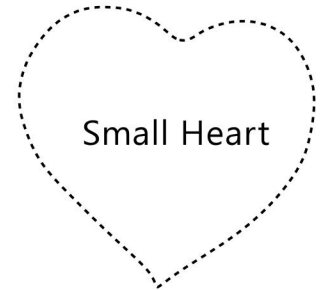

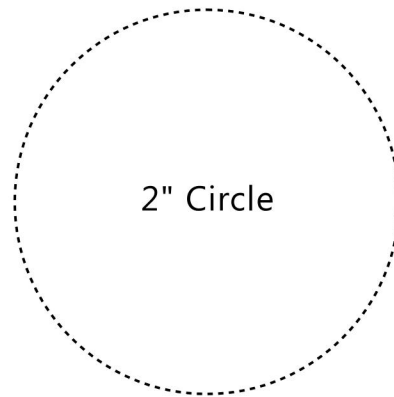
Patterns
